Many of their bodies were lost in the fields.

It wasn't a lot of money and the fields where they fought became very muddy.

It was hard for the soldiers to keep cheerful when everything was so wet and covered in mud.

The fighting was very fierce and thousands of soldiers died in the battles.

Things were hard.

Soon, because of all the mud and the fighting, the fields started to mud.

There were no trees or bushes and no plants grew there.

There was just one thing that grew in the mud. Can you guess what it was that grew there?

It was the poppy that grew in the mud. It was bright red and cheerful.

How do you think the soldiers felt when they saw the poppies?

When the war was over, people started to sell paper poppies to raise money to help all the soldiers who had been hurt in the fighting. People also wanted to remember all the soldiers who had died. They wore the poppies to help them remember and to say thank you.

Today we still remember all those soldiers when we wear the poppy. It's a special and works in all our war days this time.

When we buy a poppy we are remembering the men and women from the Air Force, the Army and the Navy.
